

Safe Routes to School Project

The City of Colby was awarded a \$250,000 grant from the Kansas Department of Transportation for a Safe Routes to School (SRTS) project, which includes repairing and constructing sidewalks and ramps to ensure students have a safe route to walk/bike to and from school.

A committee of City and law enforcement personnel, Colby Public Schools and Sacred Heart School staff and parents analyzed data gathered from SRTS surveys and walkability/bike ability checklists to develop a route for students to safely walk to and from school. The city will begin the project the middle of August. (See map)
